

Guidelines for Motion Picture Officers Active/Retired

1. Active & Retired Officers SHALL comply with all Department policies, rules and regulations regarding conduct and demeanor.
2. Officers shall not use Los Angeles Police Department equipment.
3. Officers shall cover their LAPD uniform to and from a motion picture location.
4. Motorcycles shall not have red or blue lights in front, nor blue lights in the rear and must comply with 25950 C.V.C. (Covering lights, is not permissible)
5. Officers shall maintain Department grooming standards.
6. If any changes to the Film Permit the on site, Officer shall contact FilmLA.
7. Officers shall wear ONLY the issued / authorized LAPD Badge.
8. Officers shall not park their motorcycle on the sidewalk.
9. Officers shall provide his Film Permit card to the location manager.
10. Officers shall contact the Watch Commander & communications concerning the following at a film location:
 - a. Gunfire
 - b. Vehicle Pursuit
 - c. Helicopter crash or landing / low fly's
 - d. Pyrotechnic activity (explosions)
 - e. Any Activity which may generate public attention (fight scenes, screams for help, etc.)
11. Officers shall be courteous to any citizen at film location.
12. Officers shall apply for a Motion Picture work permit and be approved **PRIOR** to working.
13. An On-Duty Officer or Supervisor auditing or inspecting the film location shall be shown a copy of the film permit.
14. An On-Duty Officer or Supervisor may close down the filming location.
 - a. At the filming location any violation must be corrected immediately
 - b. If no filming permit, all filming must cease, which may pose Liability for the City
 - c. Contact Emergency Operations Division when a film company has been order to stop filming
15. All compensation for injuries and indemnifications for civil and criminal liability extends only to the Officer's secondary employer not the City of Los Angeles.
16. The following ordinances shall apply to Officers working motion picture locations:
 - a. 52.28LAMC Police uniform limitations
 - b. 80.03LAMC Direction of traffic
 - c. 80.03.1 LAMC Traffic Control on sites
17. Officer shall obtain and be familiar with all aspects of the film permit, Special locations and filmmakers Code of Conduct".

Any violation of the motion picture filming rules and regulations could result in the suspension or revocation of the LAPD Motion Picture work permit.
